ADVENTURE OF POSSIBILITIES

In Wisconsin, you can never rule out a last minute April snowstorm, but overall the weather is trending toward spring. The robins are returning, the first flowers are peeking out, and Mercedes-Benz owners and adventurers are thinking about taking the convertible out of storage.

While we love a grand tour in a cabriolet, another great way to adventure is in an RV or motorhome. They let you hit the road for longer adventures in sunshine and in rain. And, even better for the MB enthusiast, is an RV built on the structure of a Mer-

cedes-Benz.

Multiple companies have recognized the premium craftsmanship of the Mercedes-Benz platform, and have leveraged it to create RVs that deliver luxury, safety, driving performance and comfort. The Mercedes-Benz Sprinter Van can carry a payload ranging from 3,825 pounds to 6,789 pounds and has an interior capacity of up to 532 cubic feet. That translates to plenty of room and capability for the features that make a motorhome a home.

While most RVs will have a kitchenette, bed, sitting area, and

bathroom, the variations are endless. MB-based models have been used to build both Class B and Class C motorhomes. A Class C motorhome is what may come to mind first when you think about a motorhome. They often have an over-the-cab bunk bed or storage area and can fit more people. A Class B looks more like a standard van from the outside but can still hold all the comforts of home in a compact space.

The sky's the limit when upfitting a Mercedes-Benz Sprinter with specific RV furniture and features. However, the essential capability and performance

underlying a Mercedes-Benz is what makes it a good choice for families, couples, and individuals. Features like crosswind assist, keyless start, and automatic driving lights come standard with most new Sprinter models. Advanced technology like wireless phone charging, builtin navigation, automatic braking, lane keeping assist, and the Mercedes-Benz User Experience (MBUX) multimedia system with a 10.25 inch touchscreen are all available. These can make driving a Mercedes-Benz RV safer and easier. The Sprinter is also available from Mercedes-Benz in ten bold colors.

A Mercedes-Benz may not be the right choice for every adventurer, but RVs built on the Mercedes-Benz platform offer quality, versatility, and reliability. Airstream builds all its touring coaches on the Sprinter van chassis, while Winnebago models like the View and the Bolt are also based on the Sprinter. Indi-



viduals often start with the Mercedes-Benz Sprinter when they are looking for a fully customized home on the go.




